



How to Apply for a Non-Teaching School-Based Position in New Orleans:

- Applicants for school-based positions (social workers, counselors, paraprofessionals, etc.) must meet Louisiana minimum requirements for position including, but not limited to certification and highly qualified guidelines.
- Applicants must complete the on-line “Job Application” at www.teachlouisiana.net.
- You must first create an account by completing the registration form found at <http://www.teachlouisiana.net/signup.asp>
 - Directions to complete an application:
 - create an account by completing a registration form – access this form by clicking the “New to Teach Louisiana” above the user name field
 - click the “login” link in the upper right-hand corner of the page after submitting your registration
 - visit the “Job Seekers” page and click on the “Online Job Application” link on the left-hand side
 - on the final page of the online application select “Option #1” to submit your application directly to the Recovery School District
 - scroll to the bottom of the final application page and select “Orleans Parish, Recovery School District” to submit your application to the RSD
