Who we're looking for: In order to teach in the RSD, applicants must possess a valid teaching certificate at a Practitioner Teacher License level or above in Louisiana or a standard teaching certificate from another U.S. state. If an applicant is not certified, they must provide proof of enrollment in an approved alternative certification program and have passing results for both the Praxis I and appropriate Praxis II subject tests in order to be eligible for a Practitioner Teacher License.
