How the New Process Works

As part of our plan to ensure Excellence, Equity, and Community in the Recovery School District, we committed to building a **citywide enrollment system for direct-run and charter schools**, starting in 2012. This process will be **easier for families to navigate** and will ensure that as many students as possible **get into their top choice school**

Choose to remain in your current school, or apply to new ones:

One Application

- Check a box for your child to stay in his / her current school. Or, to apply to different schools, submit one application per child, not one to each school

One Way to Rank Schools

- Students who are applying to different schools will be able to list schools in order of preference

One Set of Priorities

- A single set of priorities determines which students have the best chance of getting into each school. Detail on these priorities appears on the next page

One Timeline

- The process is not “first-come, first-served.” All applications will be considered at the same time

One Offer

- Students who are applying to different schools will receive one match, to their highest choice school that has available seats

Where you can submit the application form:

At your child’s school
(If your child is enrolled in the RSD)

OR

At an RSD Parent Center
(Page 14 has a list of Parent Centers)

The RSD's new public school enrollment process will match each student with one school, using the process described below:

1

We will honor family choice first and foremost...

- Families should rank the schools they want their child to attend
- We will try to match students with their top choice, or one of their top choices

...But some schools will have more applicants than seats

- When that happens, we will use a single set of priorities to help decide which students get those seats first:

a

Siblings of students who are currently enrolled in the school

b

Students currently enrolled in schools that are closing

c

Students who live in the school's Geographic Area

This priority applies to grades Pre-K-8 only. A map of these Geographic Areas with additional detail on this policy appears on page 5 of this packet. The school list starting on page 8 lists the Geographic Area of each school

How the process serves students with disabilities and English language learners

- Students with disabilities and English language learners may apply and be matched to any school in the RSD
- The application form that parents will submit (see page 5) does not ask about a student's disability or status as an English language learner, and the RSD will not consider this factor when matching students to schools
- If parents have a question about the services offered at any individual school, they may visit the school, one of the four RSD Parent Centers, or contact the RSD directly with questions

Frequently Asked Questions

If you have more than one child that you want to attend the same school...

You should apply for “Sibling Priority” if:

1 You would like one child to attend a school that another of your children already attends

OR

2 You have multiple children applying to a new school for 2012-13, and want these children to attend the same school

Siblings are defined as sharing a common parent / guardian OR living at the same address

Apply for sibling priority by submitting one Family Form (page 7) for your entire family, not one per child

If your child has to repeat a grade...

Students in 4th and 8th grade will still have to pass the LEAP or receive a waiver in order to advance to the next grade level

Students who have to repeat 4th or 8th grade may return to their current school, if that is what parents choose

If a family finds out that their child has to repeat a grade after they have already received an offer to change schools:

- The student can change schools if there are available seats in the right grade level
- If there are not available seats in the right grade level, RSD staff will work with families to find the best school for the child

If you are applying to a Pre-K program...

Pre-K seats in RSD schools are limited, so we cannot guarantee a seat for all children

All students with disabilities are guaranteed a seat

Students with siblings attending the school in grades Pre-K-8, or who live in the Geographic Area, will receive priority for remaining seats

Students currently enrolled in an RSD class for three-year-olds will receive priority for seats

If you are also applying to Orleans Parish schools outside the RSD...

For this year, the new enrollment process includes only schools in the Recovery School District. All RSD schools are listed on pages 8-12

If you want to apply to other Orleans Parish schools that are not listed on pages 8-12:

- Complete the application on page 6 for schools in the RSD
- Contact individual schools outside the RSD to complete applications for those schools

If you decide to enroll your child at a school outside the RSD, please contact an RSD Parent Center to decline your offer to an RSD school

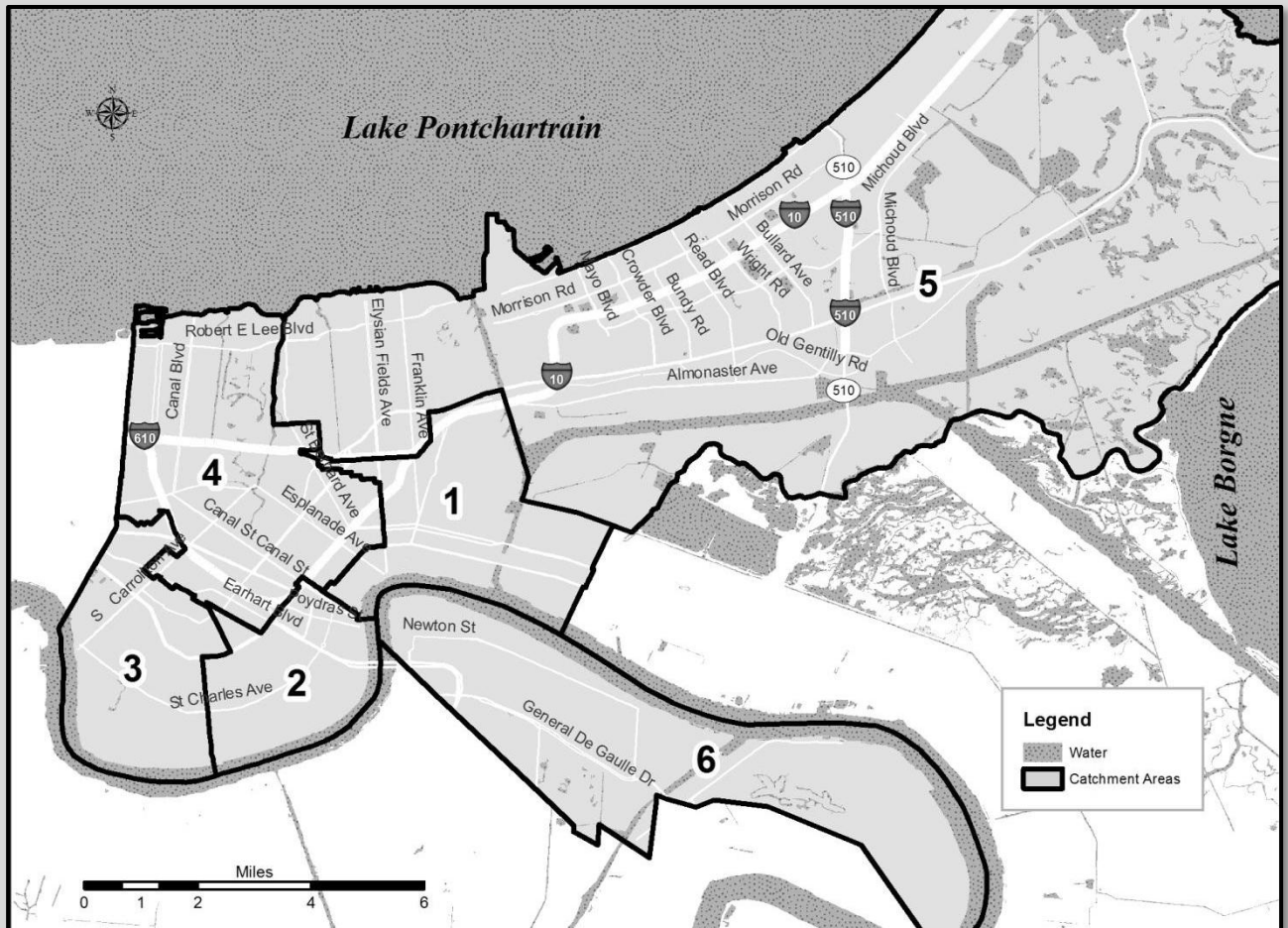
Map for Geographic Priority

Students enrolling in *Pre-K through grade 8* for the 2012-2013 school year who apply to a different school will receive priority for 50% of the available seats in the schools in their Geographic Area. This is called the geographic priority. Below is a map that divides New Orleans into 6 Geographic Areas.

RSD high schools will continue to have open citywide admissions, just as they do today. This approach maximizes student choice and allows schools to specialize in particular programs / areas.



About the Geographic Areas: The borders of the Geographic Areas are taken from the planning districts that the city used to develop its master plan for school facilities. This is to ensure that, over the long run, the districts that govern student enrollment align with the plan for where schools will be built. In some cases, we have combined more than one planning district into a single Geographic Area, to ensure that there are enough schools in each Geographic Area.

Schools closing at the end of this school year

These schools will be closing at the end of the 2011-2012 school year. Students currently enrolled at one of these schools **will not be able to return** for the 2012-2013 school year, but will have **high priority in the lottery for available seats** at all other RSD schools

- The process is aimed to match as many students as possible to one of their top choice schools. The only reason a student would not be matched to their top choice is if that school is already full.
- No student will be without a seat at the end of the process. All students will receive a placement offer, even if they don't get a top choice. If a student is not able to be matched to one of the schools ranked on page 6, that student will either be returned to his / her current school or placed in another local school.
- Families will have the option to appeal placements after receiving the letter notifying them of school placement during the week of May 1st. Further details will be included in your notification letter.
