Definitions: Landbanked and Landbanked-Occupied

- **Landbanked Campuses:** School sites that may or may not remain operating school sites in the long-term, depending on updated demographic information
- **Landbanked-Occupied Campuses:** Denotes a school program currently operating in a campus scheduled for landbanking; the RSD will determine long-term plan for the campus once demographic information is updated

Factors in Building Assignments and Recommendations

1. Whether the school program is located within existing temporary facilities;
2. Grade configuration (i.e., elementary school, high school, pre-kindergarten / current configuration, or planned configuration according to approved charter school plans);
3. Neighborhood of origin of students;
4. Facility preference of the school program;
5. Community input.
