1. **# 1 in Learning** tutors K-12 students in reading, mathematics, and English Language Arts. Focusing on the character and skills of students, tutors help them conquer the challenges of their educational careers. Tutors work to bring learners to grade level proficiency through high-quality instruction and motivational support.
2. **A to Z In-Home Tutoring** provides one-on-one tutoring in the home or location convenient for families. This tutoring service also provides small group tutoring on the school's campus. The service provides one-on-one, small group, and computer-based, self-paced tutoring services. Highly qualified tutors and managers focus students on changing study habits for improved academic performance.
12. **Grade Results** is an online instructional company offering interactive, on-demand core and fully customized learning services.
